

Recognition of satellite programmes

The GCC will review applications to run an existing recognised programme at a satellite campus on an individual basis.

The focus of the application will be on programme delivery and associated risk.

The Education Committee will seek written assurance from all providers that the GCC recognised programme delivered at a satellite centre will not deviate in any way from the original programme.

Step 1	The provider is required to contact the Education Team at the GCC to discuss a proposal.
Step 2	The provider will submit template 2.1 - outline business case, and template 3.3 - Standards mapping template, focusing on section 2 of the Education Standards only.
Step 3	The allocated Approval Panel will review the templates and it is expected that additional documentation will be required from the provider to conduct a full desk top analysis.
Step 4	An approval visit to the satellite campus will be undertaken by the Approval Panel*. During the visit, the Approval Panel will discuss with key staff the evidence in support of the programme and the intentions of the provider with respect to meeting the Education Standards.
Step 5	Approval outcome recommendation for satellite programme.
Step 6	Report and recommendation from Approval Panel considered by Education Committee.
Step	Recommendation considered by the Council of the GCC.
Step 8	Recommendation of Council progressed to Privy Council.
